DAC experienced multiple significant changes in 2023. We thank each person reading this for your patience and understanding with us, the staff, as we have navigated them. We spent the first quarter of the year working hard on building out the physical space for our BRAVE Alliance, Fort Wayne's only LGBTQIA+ youth drop-in center, and hosted a grand opening for it in April. In July, we had an unexpected change in leadership at DAC and we have worked to spend every moment since then adapting, reshaping, and responding to our community's needs. We have aged out of a few of our funding streams, restructured our committees and their meetings, re-centered our mission, and expanded our work to reach the underserved community of LGBTQIA+ youth in Allen County- and that's just to name a few of the tasks we've undertaken!

SUCCESS SPOTLIGHT

DAC is the recipient of a Community Catalyst grant for the establishment of the BRAVE Alliance. The BRAVE Alliance strives to **B**uild **R**adically **A**ffirming and **V**alidating **E**nvironments.

OPENING BRAVE:

On April 14, 2023, we hosted the Grand Opening of the physical location for the BRAVE Alliance. Many news outlets, hundreds of community members, and staff from Mayor Henry's office were present for the occasion!

BRAVE PROVIDES:

- Drop-in hours (under 35)
- Gender-affirming clothing
- Mental health counseling and therapy
- Assessments and referrals
- Support groups
- Narcan & fentanyl test strips
- Trainings for local providers

All services BRAVE offers are free to clients.

PROJECT SPOTLIGHTS

In the Fall of 2023, DAC collaborated with the Fort Wayne Police Department to design, print, and install resource cards with information about 9-8-8 and 2-1-1 in the back of police vehicles. In addition to these cards being displayed, business cards are also available at each quadrant for officers to distribute to citizens that could benefit from having the 9-8-8 or 2-1-1 information but have no need to be in the back of the police vehicle.

DAC composes and, with the help of community partners such as yourself, distributes monthly editions of something called "Dinner Dialogue." These four page newsletters are geared toward parents and guardians to encourage interconnectedness and prosocial family dialogue- particularly around the dinner table. This year, we tracked a reach of **389,521**; an all time high! We started Dinner Dialogues back in 2021 and never would have imagined they'd reach as far and wide as they do today.

DFI GRANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS

DFI funding was used to provide Intervention Scholarships to those in recovery to cover the initial costs related to recovery housing. In 2023, 101 individuals received scholarship assistance for a total of \$27,126.13 dispersed. DFI funding was also used to provide funding for community mini-grants to support a variety of community initiatives.


